1 This is a true saying, If a man desire the office of a bishop, he desireth a good work. 2 A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach; 3 Not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous; 4 One that ruleth well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity; 5 (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the church of God?) 6 Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil. 7 Moreover he must have a good report of them which are without; lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the devil.

(Six words in English Bible) shepherd, teacher, overseer, superintendent, bishop, elder

#### 1. The particular Duties of a pastor's service

**A. Feed the Flock** (group teaching, training; individual teaching, training, counsel)

I Peter 5:2 "feed(shepherd) the flock of God"

Titus 2:1 "speak...sound doctrine"

Titus 2:15 "speak, exhort, rebuke with all authority"

overseer, bishop- Acts 20:28 (episkopos)

I Timothy 3:1 bishop (episkopos)

superintend(rule)- Hebrews 13:7 (hegeomai)

Hebrews 13:17(watch for your souls--shepherd)

(stay awake over you)

elder- Titus 1:5 (presbuteros) *mature*-in word, in character

pastor -teacher- Eph 4:11 (poimen-didaskalos)

(shepherd--instructor,trainer,coach)

accept the oversight-I Peter 5:2-3 (episkopos)

not by constraint--but gladly

not for money--but with a mind to accomplish God's work not as a lord-- but a leading example to God's heritage
